# New Name Tags Are In

After discussions on how to make it easier for club members to display their field license, the club decided to institute wearable name tags. This will be great to learn the names of club members that you don't know and strike up a conversation! Plus we should all keep an eye out for any non-members using the field. Not only are they not paying their fair share to support the field maintenance, but they may be lacking insurance to protect against bodily or property damage.

If you are current with your membership, you should have received one of these babies in the mail from **Tom Young**.

If you are flying with a 72MHz transmitter, still place your card under your frequency like normal.

Flying 2.4 GHz spread spectrum, members will not have to place their card on the frequency board.

It is strongly encouraged to obey the law, especially when we do not know the consequences.
