### **Field Rules Changes**

## FPV Use At RAMS Field

At the last meeting, a discussion was held about First Person View (FPV) use at the RAMS field. There are concerns about a FPV craft colliding with another craft due to the limited perception using the goggles. There was a motion to change the Field Rules to essentially limit use of any FPV craft to the SWARM helicopter side of the field (south). The group agreed that a collision could be more likely on the airplane side (north) due to the patterns airplanes fly. A FPV flyer or flyers could use the north field as well if coordinated and agreed with members who are there.

Below are the detailed rule changes. These will be voted on at the next meeting.

#### Current:

18. Helicopters may only fly in the south area except if no airplanes are present at the field, then helicopters may also use the north area.

#### Proposed:

18. Helicopters and FPV may only fly in the south area except if no airplanes are present at the field, then helicopters and FPV may also use the north area.

#### Current:

19. Airplanes may only fly in the north area except if no helicopters are present at the field, then airplanes may also use the south area.

#### Proposed:

19. Airplanes may only fly in the north area except if no helicopters and FPV are present at the field, then airplanes may also use the south area.
