At the last meeting, **Tim Sorensen** demonstrated flight control stabilizers. His Ultra Stick receiver has a stabilizer built-in. Tim gave some tips about installing the receiver, enabling its operation on a transmitter switch, and also being able to adjust the gains on the



transmitter while testing it out.
Tim showed how the control surfaces move when he moved the plane in an unexpected way.

Welcome back to the club Andy Runte. Andy is known for combat flying and he brought in an E1000 electric combat plane, which is a newer class of competition. The plane uses a 3S 1000mah battery. For more information about the power system, go to the RCCA.
