At the Field

What to do with those Dead Li-Po Batteries?

As part of our agreement with the Franklin Fire Department, the club provides several fire extinguishers

at the field and they are purchased new each year. We also have a few buckets of sand for Li-po battery fires. If you happen to experience a fire with your batteries, a fire extinguisher will not put it out. If you can safely, go to a sand bucket, grab a scoop of sand, and smother the fire.

The sand buckets are not for disposing of your batteries. Please take them with you and dispose of them properly. We have found that the Batteries Plus store on 27th street will take them for free, while the Batteries Plus store in Hales Corners on Highway 100 will charge you \$9 per pound. The Milwaukee Metro Sewerage District (MMSD) also has drop off locations for hazardous material. I called the location on 13th



street and they said there was no charge for batteries, but haven't put that to the test yet.
