Regulations

An Update on Remote ID

Possibly the worst things to happen to our hobby since... a really windy day, the requirements of remote ID are coming soon. Beginning on September 16, 2023, the FAA will require "drone" pilots to have a remote ID broadcast module. We have seen some companies announce these modules, like the Spektrum one on the right, however, they are not in stock. Due to the lack of ability of these modules, there is speculation that this date will be delayed or at least a grace period will be announced, yet I have not seen an official announcement. However, do not fear, if you fly at the RAMS field, you will not need a remote ID module. **Tim Sorensen** shared over the IO Groups that the RAMS site was approved as a FAA Recognized Identification Area (FRIA). The approval is good until August 2027.

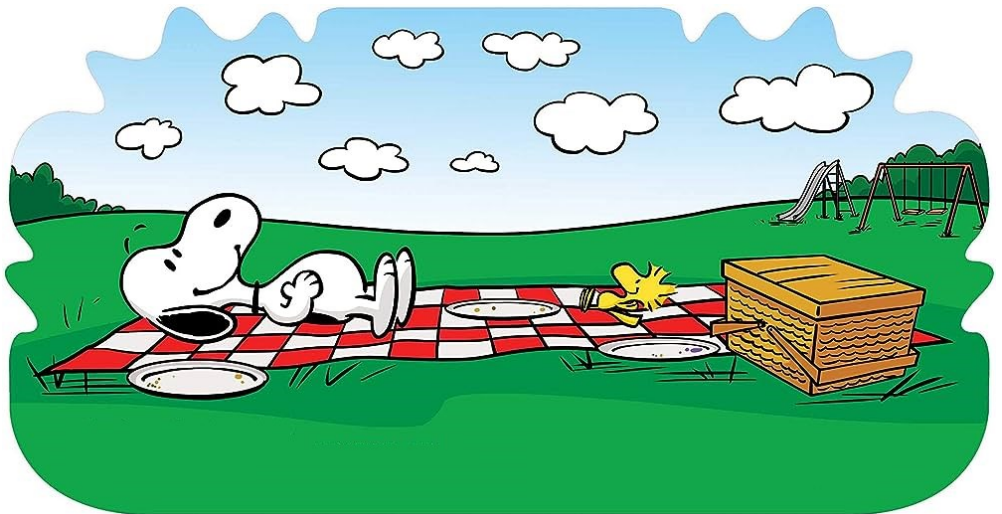
RAMS Members Picnic
