128th Air Refueling Wing

The 128th Air Refueling Wing is excited to announce it will be hosting a Base Open House on **September 13, 10AM - 4PM and September 14, 10AM - 3PM** at the General Mitchell Air National Guard Base, Milwaukee. This is a free two-day event open to the public, which offers a unique opportunity to explore military aircraft and engage with the men and women who execute the 128 ARW's global refueling mission.
