The Next Air Force One

The Air Force has unveiled what it is calling the VC-25B Bridge aircraft, a Boeing 747-800 that will serve as the Special Air Mission transport until the two long-term VC-25B's enter service in mid-2028.

The two VC-25A's based on the Boeing 747-200 have served this role since 1990 will fill other roles in the airwing until being officially retired in 2029, where hopefully at least one will find a home at the USAF Museum in Dayton, OH.
